

# Keep it clean and tidy

**Bag it** Reuse any plastic bag or newspaper to line your food caddy

# What food waste can I recycle?

- ✓ Fruit and vegetable peelings
- ✓ Cooked food
- ✓ Uncooked food
- ✓ Meat/fish (including bones)
- ✓ Plate scrapings
- ✓ Cat/dog food
- ✓ Tea bags/coffee grounds

#### Use me outside

Put your food waste in me ready for collection and don't forget to shut my lid

### Keep it fresh

Put food waste into your food caddies, not your wheeled bin.
Food waste from your food caddy is collected every week, but if it's in your bin it could be

sitting there for three weeks.
