**5. Matters Arising from the Last Meeting**

**Appreciation**

- To note thanks for the attention given to the condition of Granary Lane and the swift completion of works following the last meeting. Thanks were also received from residents of Granary Lane.
- To note that resurfacing on Station Road was carried out swiftly and smoothly, with the added benefit of increased awareness of the 20 mph speed zone.

**Speed Watch Group**

- To receive an update from Alan Chaplin.

**Madeira Walk**

- To note that while Devon Co Co manages the right of way in this location they are not the owner. At present there is no recorded owner (according the land registry).

**Traffic Emissions and Road Safety**

- To receive an update on "20 is Plenty" and "Slow Down for Budleigh" (PL).

**High Street Surface Works**

- To receive an update on progress regarding the agreed High Street patching works by Devon Highways(ES).

**Road Warden Scheme:**

- It was agreed at the last TTG meeting to recommend the above to the Town Council, a report is required.

**Knowle Hill**

- Traffic data indicates that this road (from Knowle junction to roundabout at Salterton Road) meets the required criteria and will therefore be taken through the Speed Compliance Action Review Forum (SCARF) for an assessment of the current speed limit, which is presently 40 mph. No further speed check checks will be conducted. See over for map.

6. **Parking East Budleigh Road / Top of Fore Street Hill to junction at Seachange**  
To consider concerns regarding the impact of parking on access, visibility, and highway safety. See supporting papers.
7. **Upper Station Road Car Park**  
To consider and discuss the promotion of the free car park, including ways to improve public awareness, encourage use by residents and visitors, and support local businesses through increased footfall.
8. **Manhole Cover on Exmouth Road (W3W: positions.voices.parting)**  
To note that Town Clerk has established that this is a BT cover. It has reported accordingly and will follow up to monitor action taken.
9. **Patching Works**  
Thanks were given to Highways for the recent patching works from Coast Guard Hill to East Budleigh Road. Positive feedback from residents was received and forwarded to Highways. Although the works were arranged at short notice, advance warning was provided by Highways and promoted by BSTC through its usual channels, including exterior noticeboards and social media, which received over 20,000 views. Despite best attempts there was an incident of a resident who was unaware of the works.
