The applicant (24/0640/FUL) asked for support to secure the future of Lily Farm. He said there were currently 2000 vines producing 5000 bottles of wine a year. He and his wife would be taking over the vineyard from his parents. He said the new application provided evidence there was a requirement to live on site as 24-hour presence was needed to regularly check fermenting wine.

The application was for a single storey dwelling, set into hillside. He felt the design was sympathetic and hardly visible from Dalditch Lane and would conserve and enhance the AONB and security of the vineyard for the future.
