14.128 Election of Chairman

14.131 Minutes

14.132 Chairman's Report

The Chairman, Cllr T D Wright, reported:

2. The new Interpretation board was now in place, and looking very good.

14.133 Clerk's Report

The Town Clerk, Mrs J E Vanstone, reported:

1. Jacobs have been contacted regarding the cycle racks; Mrs Vanstone had recently chased them and was hopeful that progress will be made in the next few weeks.
2. There was a report that a knob was missing from the railings at Steamer Steps, Skinners will be informed of this.

14.134 Any Other Business at the Chairman's Discretion

1. The Deputy Town Mayor, Cllr C Richards informed the committee that the Clerk was gaining quotes for repainting the lampposts.
2. Cllr A J Dent expressed concerns that motor bikes were still being parked along the fence outside the Rolle Flats. Cllr S Hall said that even when the cycle racks were sited there, they will not cover the whole area of concern, so it should be considered to move some of the benches on the seafront to this area.
3. The Chairman, Cllr T D Wright reported that the Iron Man Triathlon swimming event will be at Lime Kiln starting at 6.00am on Sunday 10 August. It was agreed that Cllr T D Wright and Cllr A J Dent would welcome the event on behalf of the Town Council.
