

## BUDLEIGH SALTERTON TOWN COUNCIL

**MINUTES** of the Meeting of the Foreshore & Footpaths Committee held in the Council Chamber on Monday 11 March 2019, on the rising of the Meeting of the Planning Committee.

### **18.458 Public Speaking Time**

No members of the public were present.

### **18.459 Apologies for Absence**

None, all Members being present.

### **18.460 Minutes**

The Minutes of the Meeting of the Foreshore & Footpaths Committee held on 12 November 2018 had been circulated prior to the Meeting. It was unanimously agreed they be signed as a true record.

### **18.461 Chairman's Report**

The Chairman, Cllr R D Sherriff had no report other than the Foreshore Walk which was covered later in the Meeting.

### **18.462 Clerk's Report**

Mrs J E Vanstone advised she had received a report that someone had stolen pebbles from the beach. The person was approached but had ignored a request to return them to the beach. The incident had been reported to East Devon District Council (EDDC) along with photographs and the car registration number.

### **18.463 Foreshore Walk**

The Chairman, Cllr R D Sherriff reported on the Foreshore Walk held on 1 March 2019.

- The shelter to the west of Steamer Steps needed some further re-pointing of some of the brick pillars. Richard Martin, EDDC StreetScene will action this
- Cliff surveying would be carried out during the week beginning 4 March. The Clerk will see if the results are available.
- It had been confirmed that the old morgue building was held under a long lease from Clinton Devon Estates by the Budleigh Salterton Angling Association. Members had carried out a temporary repair on the entrance and were intent on doing a more permanent job in due course. They were also going to clean and repaint the inside and use it for storage etc.
- The Chairman would be liaising with N Sansom with regard to the repair and repainting of the railings by the Budleigh Salterton Club. He would also liaise regarding the installation of the new hand rail by the steps on to the beach.
- Richard Martin was arranging for the 'Dogs on Lead' signs to be repainted before Easter.



- Richard would also be checking on the repairs to the railings and wall adjacent to the Jubilee Shelter.
- The beach huts would be going up in mid-March.
- Richard would be liaising with the owner of the East End Kiosk to ensure that she removes the pebbles under the netting and returns them to the beach.
- A new finger post was in place at the western entrance to Lime Kiln car park. He thought one was also needed at the eastern end of the car park as the current one was in poor condition. Devon County Council (DCC) will be asked to arrange the replacement.
- A broken post had been reported in the railings just west of the War Memorial. The Clerk advised that DCC were aware of this and would be arranging a replacement in the new financial year.
- It had been proposed that the Committee investigated the feasibility of installing a storage facility for kayaks and water sports equipment in the vicinity of the skate park in line with Community Action CLW3 of the Budleigh Salterton Neighbourhood Plan. The Chairman advised he had looked at a similar facility in Lyme Regis and was waiting for sight of the concession agreement from the company running a similar facility in Exmouth. Cllr Mrs M L Kenneally-Stone added that Prattshayes Camp Site may be interested in taking on a concession.
- Two new picnic benches had been installed on the northern side of Lime Kiln Car Park and the Chairman wondered whether it might be an idea to have two more near the children's playground. Cllr A J Dent asked who would fund these additional benches.
- Richard Martin would be arranging for a replacement shower at the east end toilets and replacement flooring to stop the area flooding.

**18.464 Any Other Business at the Chairman's Discretion**

- Cllr C A Kitson asked if there was any news of the 'No cycling' stencil. The Clerk will follow up this with Richard Martin.
- Cllr A J Dent asked if there was any action on a second water fountain at Steamer Steps. The Clerk explained she thought this was just going to be a tap, rather than a fountain and would chase up Richard Martin.
