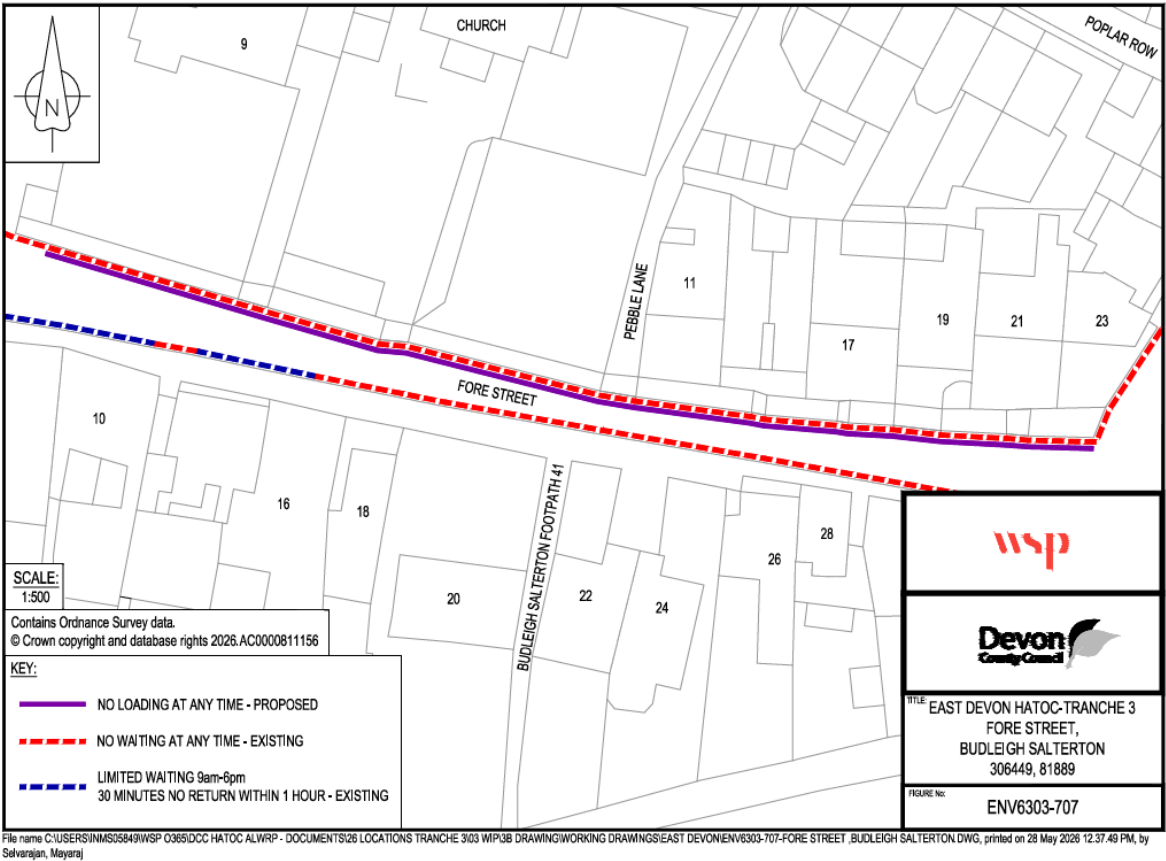
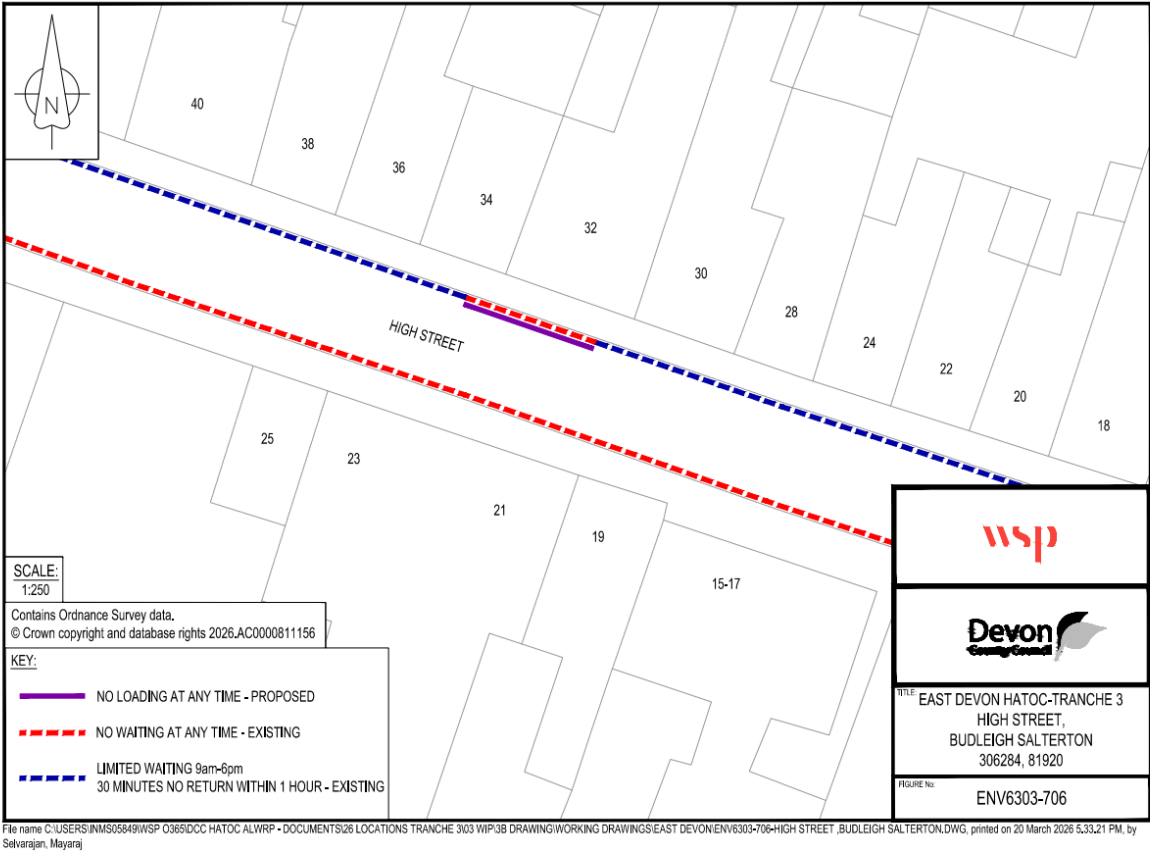

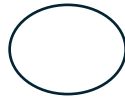

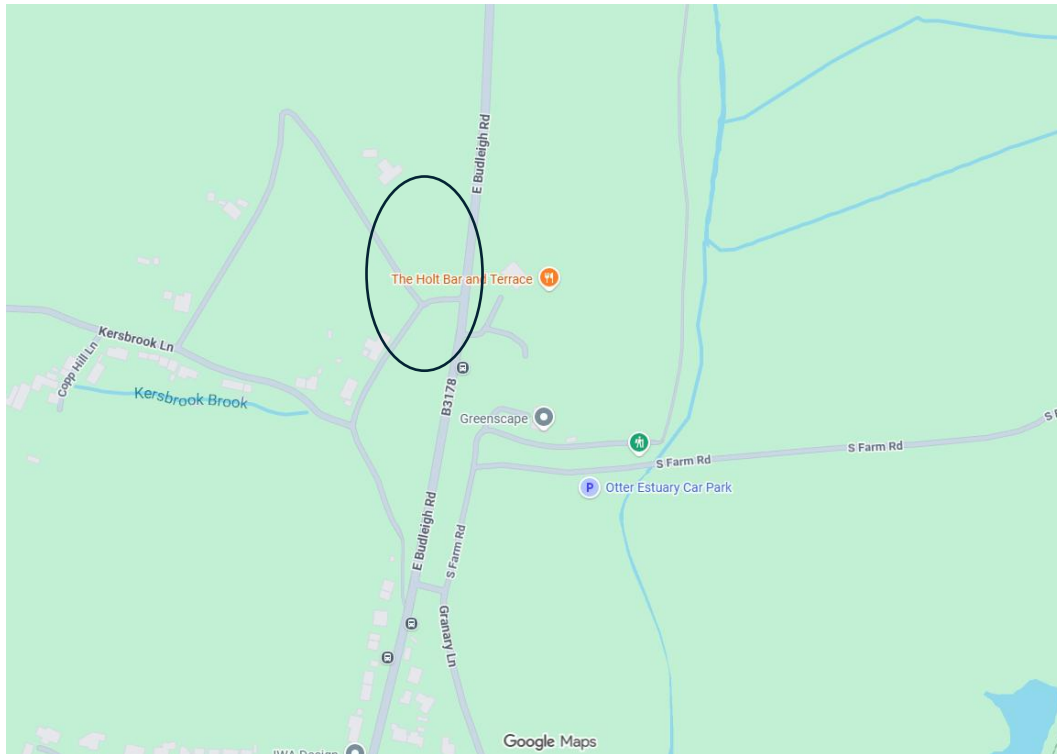
Agenda Item 7: Parking
